



### **Tibnor statement on material with Russian and Belarusian origin**

Tibnor is following EU sanctions towards Russia and Belarus for steel and metal products and is complying with

- Council regulation (EU) 2023/1214 of 23 June 2023 amending Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilizing the situation in Ukraine
- Council regulation (EU) 2023/1563 of 28 July 2023 implementing Regulation (EU) No 269/2014 concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine
- Council regulation (EU) 2022/355 of 2 March 2022 amending Regulation (EC) No 765/2006 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Belarus

Tibnor has also made the decision to stop all business (sourcing from and sales to) with Russia – even for products outside the current scope of EU restrictive measures.
